

## **BEHAVIOUR CODE OF CONDUCT**

Be responsible and look after yourself and your school

Take responsibility for my belongings and place mobile phones in lockers at the start of the student school day. They will be returned at the end of the student day. Mobile phones will **not** be available during morning break or lunchtime.
