

BEHAVIOUR CODE OF CONDUCT

- Be responsible and look after yourself and your school.
- Take responsibility for my belongings and place mobile phones in lockers at the start of the school day. They will be returned at the end of the student day. Mobile phones will not be available during morning break or lunchtime.
- The possession or use of any offensive weapons/devices or illegal substances will not be tolerated.
- Smoking and vaping is not allowed on site. All smoking materials including lighters, tobacco, vapes and matches must be in lockers from the start of the school day.
- Show respect for the feelings and opinions of all adults and children.
- We do not tolerate any bullying or racist, sexist, ageist and homophobic comments. Take responsibility for your actions.
- Follow all instructions and focus on your work. Be resilient around school at all times.
- **Children must not touch**, or take a member of staffs keys or identity badges.
- Keep your hands and feet to yourself no fighting or physical contact with others, or pulling open locked doors.
- Stay safe, be healthy and act responsibly.
